The DD Nest Hammock is covered head-to-toe in our own DD Multicam pattern, designed to make sure you blend in perfectly to woodland environments. This hammock ensures the most covert campsite possible, whilst keeping all the time-tested comfort and features that a DD Hammock provides.

Features

- Fully cloaked in DD's own Multicam **Camouflage pattern**, a versatile and complex pattern that blends in seamlessly to a multitude of natural surroundings.
- Insect-proof mesh window at the head end
- Breathable, double-layered design with velcro tab closure, insert a partially-inflated Inflatable Mat between the layers in cooler weather to give extra insulation
- 2 x foldable lightweight 60cm-wide **spreader poles** and 4 x 1m lengths of elastic cord included, to suspend the cover
- 2 x double-sided zippers for easy open and close
- 2 x internal hanging loops for torches, glasses...
- 4 internal **pockets** to store small valuables these can be used in any hammock set-up configuration!
- 4 tabs 1 on each corner of the base to peg out, to suspend equipment from or to fit a DD Underblanket
- Pre-fitted with 10m strong suspension webbing (5m each end)
- Stuff sack



How does it work?

Sleep 100% bug-free and camouflaged with the Nest Hammock's top cover zipped up, or simply unzip both sides and roll up to secure it out of the way. Alternatively, suspend the hammock with the net on the bottom to lounge out in the sun!

Set-Up Options

Fully camouflaged hammock

To suspend the top cover:

Connect the segments together on both poles, and insert them into the channels on either side of the top cover.

Tie off the supplied elastic cord to the central loop on the outwardfacing side of the pole channel, and tie off the other to the hammock suspension, tree or other attachment point.

Repeating this process on the other side, unzip the net, and climb in for a bug-free night's sleep.

There is a bug-proof fine-mesh window at the head end of the hammock - this allows you to see your surroundings fromw ithin the hammock, whilst adding to breathability and ensuring an insect-free night



Top cover rolled up

For easy access to the hammock, you can unzip the top cover, before gathering the net together at the top of the poles. This means you can easily roll down the top cover again when you need it.



Basic open hammock

If you want to get the bug net completely out of the way, you can simply remove, or omit the poles entirely and flip the hammock over so the net is on the bottom. An ideal set-up for insect-free conditions!

Using it this way you can also use it as a seat during the day.
